In response to your request for Nevada D.C. Licensure information, the following information is to help you determine if you meet all applicant criteria and whether or not you should send for the application package. The Request for Application is \$25.00 and includes a book of the Nevada laws and rules and regulations.

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE DATE:

### Education Requirements:

Graduation from high school **or** G.E.D. equivalent;

Minimum of 60 pre-chiropractic college credits **or** a minimum of five (5) years of active practice in another state; **and**

D.C. degree from chiropractic college holding an accredited status **or** a reciprocal agreement with the Council on Chiropractic Education **or** any governmental accrediting agency on the applicant's graduation date. **The graduation date on the applicant's D.C. degree is the only date accepted and must be before the application deadline for the exam date being applied for.**

### Examination Transcripts:

Passing grades in the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners exams, Parts I, II, III, IV and Physiotherapy.

**or**

Seven (7) years of active practice during the immediately preceding ten (10) years with no adverse disciplinary action; **AND** A passing grade in the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners SPEC (Special Purpose Exam for Chiropractic) test. Applicants who have not yet attained a passing score in the National Board SPEC test must have a completed application on file for the next Nevada exam in order to be authorized by Nevada to sit for the **next** SPEC test.

Applicants under the SPEC test provision who have not previously attained a passing score in the National Board SPEC test must contact the National Board to find out how to apply to take the test. The telephone number for the National Board is Greeley, Colorado is (970) 356-9100.

Nevada has **no reciprocity** with other states and the law makes no allowance for consideration of length of practice in another state except as stated above. Applicants must complete the application form accurately and honestly, pay the application and examination fees and take the required Nevada exam.

All applicants will be tested by the Board in Nevada law. A minimum score of **75%** is required. Applicants have two chances within one (1) year to pass the required exam.

All applicants must submit fingerprints and affidavits of good moral character on forms provided with the application package. An arrest record, conviction of a crime or disciplinary action taken against one's license by another state does not preclude acceptance of an applicant. However, if additional information or further inquiry is deemed necessary there may be a delay in acceptance of the applicant to sit for the exam. The Board may reject an application based on their determination as to the applicant's moral character.

The application deadline is established under NRS 634.080(1), "An applicant for examination must file an application not less than 60 days before the date of the examination". **However, please make note that an application is not complete until the fee and all of the supporting documents are received, and a background check has been conducted, including clearance of the applicant's fingerprint check.**

**APPLICANTS WILL NOT BE APPROVED TO SIT FOR THE LAW EXAMINATION UNTIL FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE HAS BEEN RECEIVED. This may result in a delay until the next examination date.**

The following statute, **NRS 634.013 "Chiropractic" defined, is the scope of practice in**

**"Chiropractic is defined to be the science, art and practice of palpating and adjusting the articulations of the human body by hand, the use of physiotherapy, hygienic, nutritive and sanitary measures and all methods of diagnosis".**

Nevada Licensed Chiropractors may not perform surgery or dispense or prescribe drugs. They may not perform acupuncture unless licensed by the Nevada State Board of Oriental Medicine.
