Mr. Jackson determined that a quorum of the Committee was not present and there will be no action taken. He called the meeting to order which will be for information only.

Agenda Item 1 Discussion/possible action regarding bill amendments in committee.

Marsha reported that the amendment to AB382 got pulled because of the problems with the issue of malpractice coverage for preceptor student. The Board will need to address this by regulation. Dr. Lurie commented that the definition of a preceptorship in this bill differs from that of the insurance company, NCMIC.

AB412, the homeopath bill, was successfully amended and the word "adjustment" was removed.

SB215, the bill to require CE for CAs was amended, correcting the renewal date.

Agenda Item 2 Discussion/possible action regarding bills on the floor.

There are currently no bills on the floor that we need to watch.

Agenda Item 3 Discussion/possible action regarding all relative bills.

The sunset bills, including SB251 and AB455, are to be combined into one bill. It will be in final form sometime next week.

AB36, a Podiatry Board bill, contains language requiring notification within 14 days of the location and custodian of the patient records of a licensee whose office has closed.

There will be a work session in the next few days on SB43, the electronic health records bill.
