Basic Chiropractic Knowledge

Chiropractic modalities (physiologic effects, indications, contraindications/red flags, special precautions, dosage, treatment time, patient positions, safe application, and treatment termination procedures)

- Ice/cryotherapy
- Heat/hydrocollator
- Contrast therapy/baths
- Diathermy
- Microcurrent
- Ultrasound
- Electrotherapy/EMS
- US/EMS combination therapy
- Therapeutic lasers (Class I-IV)
- Traction
- Therapeutic and home exercises
